



**COGNITIVE-BEHAVIORAL THERAPY FACILITATOR
(\$2,500 - 4,000 monthly)**

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Under the supervision of the Case Worker Supervisor, the Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy Facilitator (CBT Facilitator) provides evidence-based CBT programs and other life skills programs to parolees, conducts group and individual meetings utilizing motivational interviewing techniques, tracks, documents, and evaluates the progress of parolee clients, works with parolees, parole agents, and DRC staff to develop, implement, and adjust the Case Management Plan (CMP), and maintain a dynamic set of evolving CBT treatment skills and education.

Must be able to pass CDCR clearance. A criminal record will not automatically disqualify applicants.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Education:

1. An Associates degree or equivalent units from an accredited college or university in the fields of education, psychology, social work, health, criminal justice or related field.

Experience:

1. Two years of experience working with high risk youth or adults and/or very low income families desirable.
2. Two years successful experience in coordinating and facilitating group interactions, meetings, and/or training desirable.
3. Demonstrated successful experience working with educational or social service programs and/or services.

Knowledge of/Ability to:

1. Provide case management services to at-risk or high-risk adults and families
2. Facilitate positive working relationships between the DRC programs, service providers, partnering agencies and administration.
3. Provide support to clients and their families during their transition back into the community.
4. Work with diverse community groups and populations.

5. Organize and support various transition activities.
6. Provide trainings to clients, DRC staff, and agency partners.
7. Work effectively as a team member with all partners.
8. Apply excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
9. Proficiency in use of telecommunications and computer applications related to position.
10. Prepare and maintain accurate records.
11. Work productively, creatively, and with independent initiative.
